Industry Benchmarking

NCHL conducts four annual benchmarking surveys to assess trends, impact, and challenges that exist in the graduate healthcare administrative fellowship area. Responses provide members with key knowledge on the current state of fellowships and aids in navigating the future of administrative fellowships.
