# National Council on Administrative Fellowships (NCAF) – Premier Program Overview

NCAF provides administrative fellowship sites and graduate programs the tools to help their students when applying for administrative fellowships by creating a uniform coordinated recruitment process, providing access to national industry data, and providing opportunities for fellowship sites to share ideas, best practices, and expectations that allow for preparation of students for administrative fellowships.

More than 80 hospitals and health systems, along with more than 35 graduate health management programs participate in NCAF. Starting in 2024, NCAF membership consists of a Standard Membership of \$1,250. Membership cycles run from January through December. New NCAF Fellowship Sites who join are charged a one-time administrative fee of \$500 to get set-up.
